### AV2006 Day Worker Applications

TO:

National Rover Council Executive  
Branch Rover Council Chairmen

A number of Rover's from different Branches have brought it to mine and the NRC Vice Chairman's attention that they would like to assist at Roverscope at the 2006 Australian Venture in NSW, but the cost is something that is prohibiting them on attending.

Jason Thomson (NRC Vice Chairman) and myself have been in discussions with the Venture Organising Team about ways to reduce the cost of going to the Venture, and have found a solution. Applications for Day Workers are now being accepted by the Venture Organising Committee as another way for people to attend the Venture, and assist with the setting up and running of Roverscope 2006.

Some restrictions have been placed on these positions, as outlined below:

- Restricted to only working a maximum of 5 days;
- Responsible for their own transport to and from the Venture site and/or Expedition site; and
- The Venture Organising Committee will allocate a job best suited their skills and the needs of the VOC.

As a Day Worker you can choose to be a member of your Branch's Contingent, though you must be approved by the Contingent Leader regardless of your choice. If you choose not to be a member of your Contingent then you do not receive any of the Contingent Kit, you are not eligible for any services provided by the Contingent nor will you be recorded by your Branch as having attended the Venture.

Also you are not automatically eligible for the Venture Kit, though you can elect to purchase this kit at an additional cost of \$30.00. The Venture Kit consists of the Venture T-Shirt, the Venture Hat, a water bottle, the Venture Badge and a Leaders' Manual.

The costs involved in being a day worker are:

- Once off Administration Fee \$15.00
- Daily Fee (each day onsite) \$25.00 (per day onsite)
- Venture Kit (optional) \$30.00
- Contingent fee (optional) as set by your State Contingent

Applications still need to be made online (<http://www.venture.scouts.com.au>) through the Online Application Process. When you get to the “skill/job” tab, select “I am a Day Worker ONLY”, and further in the form (possibly the same page) write that you are assisting on Roverscope. The form needs to be printed off and sent into your Branch Headquarters (with payment) for approval and verification. If you have problems with the application process, please contact the Roverscope Co-ordinator (Adz McLean). Also, once you have applied, please email the Roverscope Co-ordinator, so when the request comes through to approve you to be on Roverscope, he knows that you have applied.
