<b>Primary Purpose:</b>	As a member of the Implementation team, 1. Ensure all tools, programs, guidelines, publications and other resources listed in the implementation recommendations have been 2. Developed and meet the expectations of both NRC and NOC. Develop the implementation plan and tools to successfully embed all review outcomes across Australia.

### **Functions:**

1. Meet as a member of the implementation team.
2. Collaboratively ensure that all review requirements are developed to meet the approval of both NRC and NOC. This will include;
  - a. Attending weekend meetings at the Scouts Australia office, Chatswood NSW
  - b. Researching key requirements to develop the policies and procedures of each recommendation
  - c. Developing recommendations, guidelines and documents between meetings
  - d. Reviewing current documents
  - e. Working with other Rovers and leaders to get feedback and to validate work
3. Develop a plan, tools and documents to support the implementation of all recommendations to all Rovers across Australia and other relevant leaders.
